

AIRPORT BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT
ORDER OF DECISION—HAS 2021-HV28

The Airport Board of Adjustment held a meeting on **March 18, 2021** to hear a **request for a variance from Sections 9-709, 9-711, and 9-751, of the Airport Land Use Regulations Ordinance, Article VII, Chapter 9, City of Houston Code of Ordinances:**

To allow for the construction of a new single-family residential home at HCAD Parcel No. 093-168-000-0565, in the Glen Lee Place Subdivision, Houston, TX.

The meeting was called to order at 6:20 p.m. with the following board members, constituting a quorum for action, in attendance:

Following preliminary administrative matters unrelated to the variance request, the presentation and public hearing was opened at 6:46 p.m., and closed at 6:48 p.m. City representatives and the Applicant, Francis Ortiz, presented evidence and made comments. Witnesses were not sworn in. There were no other witnesses, and the exhibits received are included in the case file.

Following the public hearing, presentation of evidence, and discussion by the Board, Board Member Gant made a motion:

To approve variance HAS 2021-HV28, to allow the construction of a new single-family residential development at HCAD Parcel No. 093-168-000-0565, Glen Lee Place Subdivision, Houston, TX.

The Board found that granting the variance was appropriate based on the evidence presented during the hearing, all required findings were made and the granting of the variance was in accordance with the spirit of the airport land use ordinance.
