AIRPORT BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

Order of Decision – HAS 2017-HV19 October 24, 2017

The Airport Board of Adjustment held a meeting on October 24, 2017 to hear a request for a variance from Chapter 9, Article VII, the Airport Hazard Area Ordinance, of the City of Houston Code of Ordinances to allow for the construction of a new single family residence at 16307 Green Manor Drive in the Glen Lee Place Subdivision near George Bush Intercontinental Airport.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. with the following board members in attendance:

Following preliminary administrative matter unrelated to the variance request, the public hearing was opened and closed by the chair. City representatives and the Applicant presented evidence and made comments. Witnesses were not sworn in. A list of witnesses and exhibits received is included in the case file.

Following the presentation of evidence and discussion by the Board, Board Member Gant made a motion to approve the request by the applicant to construct a single-family home at 16307 Green Manor Drive in the Glen Lee Place subdivision near George Bush Intercontinental Airport, Houston, Texas as follows:

Motion:

To approve variance HAS 2017-HV19, to allow the construction of a single family home at 16307 Green Manor Drive in the Glen Lee Place subdivision near George Bush Intercontinental Airport, with the condition that the property owner provided an avigation easement.

The Board finds that granting the variance is appropriate based on the evidence presented during the hearing, since the site is located within a subdivision platted prior to the effective date of Article VI and VII of the Code of Ordinances. The Board further finds that granting the variance under these circumstances will result in substantial justice being done, not be contrary to the public interest, and is in accordance with the spirit of the airport hazard ordinance.
