- As part of the solicitation, respondents shall attest that they understand and agree not to contact any members of City Council or City employees – other than the solicitation contact person – during the Quiet Period.

Submittal Procedures

- All submittals must be labeled on the outside of the box "ITB No.:HOA-13R-31L-2023 024, PN982— REHABILITATION OF RUNWAY 13R-31L at HOU" in the subject line and provide all applicable contact information.

RFQ Submittal Requirements



- → Each Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) must be organized and follow the required format as stated in Section 9.0 – Step One: Request for Qualifications.
- → Each item of Step 1, RFQ Content must be appropriately tabbed and inclusive of all the required submittals.
- → Submissions to the RFQ must be valid for a period of one hundred and eighty (180) consecutive calendar days from the date of receipt by the City.

Evaluation Criteria



The Respondents Must Meet The Following Minimum Qualifications: (Pass/Fail)

- 1- All submitters must have a minimum of five (5) Years of Airport design experience
- 2- Respondent must have, and maintain, an active License to Perform Professional Engineering Services in the State of Texas.
- 3- Respondent must have and maintain the minimum insurance coverage and liability limits as outlined in this Request for Qualifications
- 4- Respondent must include a minimum of 1 (one) of similar project.

Evaluation Criteria



Financial Capabilities (Pass/Fail)

- 1- Respondent is required to submit, in a separate, sealed envelope, clearly marked "Financial Statements", one(1) stamped "Original".
- 2- Respondent must provide audited financial statements if they are available. If audited financial statements are not available, Respondent must provide tax returns along with unaudited or reviewed financials for the last two (2) years.
- 3- Provide a brief statement of the Respondent's bonding ability to fulfill the obligations.



General Description of Design Scope of Work

- Runway Pavement Design Full depth concrete to accommodate current standards (ADG -III)
- Designs for TWY connectors including High speed exits
- Pavement marking, Electrical signage, lighting system upgrade using LED
- Drainage Improvements
- Pavement shoulder upgrades
- Produce IFB, IFC drawings, specifications, and Contract Documents.
- Produce Rough of magnitude Cost (ROM) for the project
- Provide Construction Administration services
