Requiring the applicant to bring the retention pond into compliance before the issuing of building permits for the new development is considered onerous both in time lost and cost incurred to the applicant since the current situation was created by COH staff discrepancy. Upon the condition that the applicant enter into a binding contract with the City of Houston and the Houston Airport System to modify the pond to meet FAA recommendations and comply with both ordinances if the client purchases the property, substantial justice will be done by granting the variance.

The Board further finds that granting the variance under these circumstances will result in substantial justice being done, not be contrary to the public interest, and is in accordance with the spirit of the airport hazard ordinance.
