On-Call Design Services Goals

The Houston Airport System's Office of Business Opportunity is committed to creating a level playing field. A level playing field is achieved through various means to include setting utilization goals on contracts. On-Call Design Services contracts have separate distinct contract goals.

Applying for City of Houston Certification Timeline

City of Houston OBO – Certification Unit certifies firms meeting the criteria for M/W/S/DBE Certification.

MWSBE Certification requires an online application and can range between **60-120 days** for processing.

DBE Certification require an online application and can range between **30-120 days** for processing.

Should you identify a subcontractor eligible for certification but not yet certified, please urge them to apply online as soon as possible at <u>City of Houston - Mayor's Office - Office of Business Opportunity (mwdbe.com)</u>.
