

Evaluation Process



- A Committee Of Five Members Will Be Appointed To Each Of The Procurements
 - Three Of The Members Will Be Appointed By The Director Of The Houston Airport System
 - Two Other Members Will Be Appointed To Serve From Other City Departments With Relevant Expertise



Evaluation Process (Cont'd)



- Observers Will Participate From The Office Of Business Opportunity, The Office
 Of The Chief Procurement Officer, The City Attorney's Office, And The Office Of
 The Director Of PWE
- Written Submittals/Proposals Will Be Evaluated And Scored First
- A Short List Of Firms May Be Asked To Participate In Oral Interviews



Evaluation Process (cont'd)



The Team Leader Will Prepare An Executive Summary Reflecting The Committee's Recommendation. The Summary Will Detail Strengths And Weaknesses Of The Short-Listed Firms And Explain Why The Recommended Firm Rose To The Top



Procurement Process Reminders



- The Quiet Period Begins On The Date The Solicitations Are Published
 - Contact Only With The Designated Procurement Specialist
 - Quiet Period Extends Until An Award Recommendation Appears On A City Council Agenda, Including A City Council Committee Meeting Agenda
- Debriefings Will Be Held After Awards Are Made
