  - I. Response to Questions
- 1. **Question:** Please provide information as to where the General Contractor can setup a parking/lay down area, as well as where dumpsters will be allowed to be kept.

**Response:** General Contractor can utilize the area in the attached Google Maps photo highlighted in red (Google Maps for HOU Restrooms Project Laydown Area). The area is adjacent to the "Cell Phone" lot in the NW area of Hobby Airport along Airport Blvd. This area can be used for a material laydown area and employee/subcontractor parking. A covered dumpster that complies with HAS's standards will be allowed on the airfield, the exact location will be determined after contract award as approved by HAS and Airline Ground Operations.

2. **Question:** Will an area be provided for material storage and laydown?

3. **Question:** Please provide location of Dumpster storage for pickup.

4. Question: Dimensions for the Dustwall - protrusion into the terminal from wall.

**Response:** Dustwall must be cleaned and painted to represent an aesthtically pleasing and professional appearance to airline passengers and patrons. Dustwall cannot protrude more than 3'-0" into the Concourse space from the existing Concourse Wall.

5. **Question:** PM-3 - References spec section 10-28-13 - there is no such specification provided.

**Response:** PM-3 is a surface mounted mirror. The toilet accessory specification section is 102800, not 102813 as noted.

6. Question: Clarify color selection for MC1.

**Response:** See the Material Legend Sheet A0.20, the color is noted as PDR30113 ACROGUARD BIANCO.

7. Question: Please provide clarification on worker and equipment entry locations and access to the site.

**Response:** Contractor can utilize the Loading Dock Area with Elevator nearest the Food Court and Gates 40-43 restrooms on the second floor. See the attached "Drawings for "Restroom Loading Dock Elevator Location". Contractor will need to contact the Hobby Badging Office to attain badging and proper escort credentials for employee/subcontractor access into the Secure Area.

8. **Question:** Spec Section 09-29-00 calls for a Level 5 Joint finish. As the walls are being covered with a wall panel system is this required.

**Response:** Level 5 finish is not required where gypsum board walls are covered with a wall panel system. Tape and float the joints is sufficient.

9. **Question:** Provide specifications for water proofing to be used per note 2/A0.20 - not within spec book.

Response: Please see attached revised specification Section 09 03 00 TILING.

 Question: Please provide information and clarification on the location of contractor parking while working within the terminal.

Response: Please refer to the response provided to Question #1.

11. **Question:** Please provide details on the phasing requirements.

**Response:** Due to the proximity of the restrooms in the Terminal, only one set of Men's/Women's restrooms can be closed at one time. Thus, construction of one set of restrooms must be completed and a certificate of occupancy received from the Building Standards Group (BSG) before construction can begin on the second set of restrooms. It is recommended that the Contractor begin with the Gates 40-43 Restrooms first.

## II. REVISED DRAWINGS TO REPLACE/SUPPLEMENT ORIGINAL DRAWINGS

Revised Drawings, all dated 03.26.2020, are for the installation of new digital signage for the Men's and Women's Restroom Entries (four (4) ea. digital signs). The digital signs will be provided by the Owner through Trax Analytics and coordination & installation shall be provided by the Contractor. The Trax Analytics' Digital Signage Installation Guide is included for reference.
