I. To Respond to Questions

1. Question: A major portion of the project entails removing NUC/DDC players from the monitors and relocating them to the closest IDF closet. Please provide the necessary cabling length from each FIDS bank to the closest IDF closet.

Response: Means and methods can impact the cable lengths; and therefore, it is the responsibility of the contractor performing the work. HAS will note that the FID bank and the IDF rooms that serve each location are located on the plans with scaled drawings. The pathways area design to fall within the allowable Cat 6 cable length range of 295 linear feet.

2. Question: Infax could either prime or sub this project and is trying to determine our best role moving forward. Please provide a list of potential prime candidates or subcontractors that have downloaded or received copies of this RFP.
