- Each item of Step 1, RFQ Content must be appropriately tabbed and inclusive of all the required submittals.
- Submissions to the RPQ must be valid for a period of one-hundred and eighty (180) consecutive calendar days from the date of receipt by the City.
- Forms to be submitted with the SOQ are listed in Part VI, Section 18.0 and must be properly and completely filled-up.




Overview:


The Houston Airport System (HAS) has identified an existing proposed site to be used as a container dump site and as a training facility for K-9 dogs. This site will be a gated, fenced secured facility for the dump site using chain linking and electronic card readers. For additional security, the HPD office, K-9 area, and bunkers will have additional gates with card readers and chain link fencing surrounding their areas. The chain link and gates for the HPD office, K-9 area, and bunkers will incorporate privacy fence slats for additional security. Both sites will have security cameras at various locations. Currently the site has two existing houses and a warehouse that will need to be demolished. Existing vegetation and debris from this site will need to be removed and properly disposed. 16
