Re: Cancellation Notice on the Request for Qualification (RFQ) – Design-Build-Operate-Maintain the Skyway APM System Replacement; Solicitation # HJA-APMDBOM-2024-005

Thank you for your submission on the RFQ for the Design-Build-Operate-Maintain the Skyway APM System Replacement; Solicitation # HJA-APMDBOM-2024-005. This correspondence serves as official notice that the aforementioned RFQ has been cancelled.

Section 10.5.11 of the RFQ states, "City reserves the right to cancel this RFQ, accept or reject, in whole or in part any or all SOQs received in the best interest of the City."

We are currently in the process of updating our Master Plan, a multi-year process, for George Bush Intercontinental Airport, which will include projections for future passenger traffic. At this time, it is in the best interest of the City to wait for the completion of the Master Plan, and associated future passenger traffic projections, to ensure the appropriate mobility capacity requirements are considered prior to embarking on replacement of the existing system.

At such time as the Houston Airport System (HAS) deems replacing the Skyway APM System is in the best interest of the City, a new project solicitation will be advertised in the newspaper and on the HAS website (Fly2houston.com).
